2. WEANLING/YEARLING HALTER

*****3. OPEN MODEL HALTER**

4. WESTERN MARE HALTER

5. WESTERN STALLION/GELDING HALTER

6. PONY HALTER: Ponies 54" & under

****7. SHOWMANSHIP:** Exhibitor 13 & over

****8. PEE WEE SHOWMANSHIP:** Exhibitor 12 & under

*****9. PEE WEE/YOUTH GAITED PLEASURE:** Walk & favorite gait, light or heavy shod. Rider 18 & under.

10. JR. HORSE WALK TROT: Stock Horses 5 years old and younger. Snaffle bit and bosal only. Proof of age required.

****11. LEADLINE:** Rider 6 & under. Rider not eligible for any other class except halter.

12. PEE WEE FLAG: Rider 12 & under

13. YOUTH FLAG: Rider 13 thru 18.

14. SENIOR FLAG: Rider 19 & older.

****15. PEE WEE WALK TROT:** Rider cannot show in any other Pleasure or English class. English or Western tack & attire acceptable. Rider 12 & under.

16. OPEN ENGLISH PLEASURE: English attire & tack req.

*****17. PLANTATION CLASS:** Walk & running walk, light or heavy shod. Max. 8" shank on bridle, tack optional, no pads. (including wedge pads). No canter.

****18. OPEN ENGLISH EQUITATION:** May be asked extended trot, halt, post no stirrups, hand gallop, etc.

*****19. LT. SHOD COUNTRY PLEASURE:** Walk & favorite gait, max. 3/8" x 3/4" shoe, max. 8" shank on bridle, tack optional.

****20. ADULT WALK TROT:** Rider cannot show in any Other Pleasure or class. English or Western Tack & attire acceptable. Rider 19 & over.

21. PEE WEE BARRELS: Rider 12 & under.

22. YOUTH BARRELS: Rider 13 thru 18.

23. SENIOR BARRELS: Rider 19 & over.

****24. YOUTH WALK TROT:** Rider cannot show in any Other Pleasure or English class. English or Western tack & Attire acceptable. Rider 13 thru 18.

***25. MYSTERY CLASS:** To be announced day of show

26. SR. WESTERN PLEASURE: Rider 19 & over.

27. PEE WEE POLES: Rider 12 & under.

28. YOUTH POLES: Rider 13 thru 18.

29. SENIOR POLES: Rider 19 & over

30. PEE WEE/YOUTH WESTERN PLEASURE: Rider 18 and under.

*****31. OPEN GAITED PLEASURE:** Walk, favorite gait, light or heavy shod, maximum of 8" shank on bridle, tack optional, no pads (including wedge pads). No canter.

32. OPEN WESTERN PLEASURE

***33. PEE WEE EGG & SPOON:** Rider 12 and under

***34. YOUTH & SENIOR EGG & SPOON:** Rider 13 & over

(Time & enough spotters permitting for both egg & spoon classes.)

*** NO POINTS FOR CLASSES 25, 33 AND 34 **POINTS ON RIDER/EXIBITOR *** WE RESERVE THE RIGHT TO HIRE AND USE QUALIFIED VETERINARIANS, DQPS OR FARRIERS TO CHECK FOR UNSOUNDNESS**

NEGATIVE COGGINS REQUIRED ON ALL HORSES AND PONIES. MUST HAVE PAPERS AT GATE

RULES

- 1) No stallion by youth exhibitors on grounds during show.
- 2) Ponies 54" & under will be kept on file.
- 3) No entering the ring at a run for any class.
- 4) Disqualification: Hitting in front of the saddle.
- 5) 5 second penalty for each barrel downed. 2 second penalty for knocking down each pole.
- 6) All dogs must be on a leash at all times.
- 7) Request a tack change one class prior to class. 3 minutes allowed on tack change.
- 8) Judges decisions are final.
- 9) High point winner must show 4 out of 6 shows to be eligible.
- 10) Abusive behavior in or out of the show ring will not be tolerated.
- 11) No alcoholic beverages permitted on show grounds.
- 12) Proper attire required for all classes.
- 13) Exhibition and showing horse in same class is prohibited.
- 14) Full Rules and Regulations are posted at Registration
- 15) Horse must be registered for class two classes prior. No class changes after 1pm.
