Entry fee will be \$20.00 per horse/rider combination. Additional horses/same rider combinations will be \$5.00 each. Members of the same family may exhibit the same horse; however each rider must pay the entry fee.

Premiums will be awarded on the Danish System for classes judged on the exhibitor (showmanship, horsemanship and equitation): Blue \$8.00, Red \$6.00 & White \$5.00. Ribbons will be awarded to the first 5 places in each class.

Novice classes are for riders in their first or second year of competition or for those riding green horses in their first or second year under saddle. Those in novice classes will be disqualified for loping/cantering.

Class 7 is open to 4-H members that are just beginning under saddle. They may only enter classes 3 & 7.

All horses must be checked-in between 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. Any 4-H or FFA member in good standing from Callaway County or a reciprocating county who is enrolled in the Horse Program is eligible to participate.

Riders may only compete in one division with each individual horse for the entire show. There is to be no cross entering of horses unless riders are siblings in different divisions. Novice riders may not lope in any class and will be disqualified for doing so.

All exhibitors are required to wear their entry number in all judged classes and have appropriate attire and tack for each class. Any exhibitor without appropriate attire may be excused from the class. In case of extreme heat, long sleeved shirts and chaps may be optional at judge's/superintendent's discretion.

ASTM helmets are required for all speed events and English classes for all participants. Rider will be disqualified if helmet is not worn and properly fastened while in the arena. Helmets can be worn in any class.

4-H exhibitors must show completed 4-H enrollment form including negative Coggins.

All coaching must cease when rider enters the arena. Sideline/rail coaching will not be tolerated and will result in rider disqualification.

Please notify show office of tack changes to hold the gate.

Gate will close at third call if not notified of tack change.
