- Youth Pole Bending (10 years and under; Horse or Pony; Helmet required)
- 13 Junior Pole Bending (11 thru 15 years; Horse or
- 14 Senior Pole Bending (16 years or older)
- Junior Western Pleasure (15 years and under; 55" 15 and over)
- 16 Junior Country Pleasure (15 years and under; flat foot walk and favorite gait; open tack and attire; no pads)
- Junior Walk-Trot (12 years and under; Horse or pony: 17 gaited excluded; rider cannot ride in class 8, 11, 15,19, 23, 24, 29, or 31)
- Senior Country Pleasure (16 years and older; flat foot walk and favorite gait; western tack and attire; lite shod shoes only)

- Pony Pleasure (13 years and under; 55" and under; rider cannot show lead line or walk trot)
- Youth Barrels (10 years and under; Horse or pony; 20 helmet required)
- 21 **Junior Barrels** (11 thru 15 years; Horse or pony)
- 22 **Senior Barrels** (16 years or older)
- 23 Non-Stock Open Pleasure (All ages; 55" or over; Arab /Morgan/Saddlebred types; gaited excluded)
- Stock Type Open Western Pleasure (All ages; Men and 24 Women; 55" and over)
- 25 **Plantation** (All ages, heavy shod)
- 26 Open Lite Shod Pleasure (All ages; flat foot walk and favorite gait; western tack and attire; lite shod shoes only)
- 27 **Junior Flag** (15 years and under; Horse or pony)
- 28 **Senior Flag** (16 years and over)
- 29 Adult Walk-Trot (13 years and over; gaited excluded; riders cannot ride in class 8, 11, 15, 19, 23, 24, 29, or
- 30 Western Horsemanship Walk-Trot (All ages; riders cannot ride in class 8, 11, 15, 19, 23, 24, 29, or 31)
- 31 **Junior Horse** (Stock-Type Horses 5 years and younger)

Rules for Exhibitors

Must show 4 of 6 point shows to be eligible for high point award. Nomination fee must have been paid to qualify for points.

Exhibitors under 18 years must have a parent or responsible party sign for them. (DOB from January 1)

Suitable attire required in all classes.

Hats required in all classes but speed.

Helmet required on all youth ages 10 and under in all speed classes.

Hitting a horse in front of saddle is a disqualification.

Palming a barrel is a disqualification.

Knocking down a barrel is a 5 second penalty.

Boots with defined heels are required for all riding classes.

Gaited Horses - No pads, open frog, legal plantation shoes.
