- 10. Junior Country Pleasure (Riders 15 yrs old and under, walk and favorite gait, tack optional, NO PADS, BANDS or ACTION DEVICES- Gaited horses only)
- 11. Junior Walk Trot (Riders 15 yrs and under, horse or pony)
- 12. Open Country Pleasure (Any age rider, walk and favorite gait, tack optional. NO PADS, BANDS or ACTION DEVICES- Gaited horses only)
- 13. Pony Western Pleasure (Ponies 54" and under, Riders 10 yrs old and under)
- 14. Senior Western Pleasure (Riders 16 yrs old and over)
- 15. Junior Western Pleasure (Riders 15 yrs old and under, horse or pony)

- 16. Open Plug (Any age rider, horse or pony)
- 17. Junior Poles (Riders 15 yrs old and under, horse or pony)
- 18. Senior Poles (Riders 16 yrs old and over)
- 19. Open 2D Poles, 2 second split, \$10 entry fee 80% PAYBACK class
- 20. Open Flag (Any age rider, horse or pony)
- 21. Senior Barrels (Riders 16 yrs and over)
- 22. Junior Barrels (Riders 15 yrs and under, horse or pony)
