- 1. Pony Miniature Horse Halter (Pony not to exceed 54")
- 2. Stock type Geldings/Stallions Halter
- 3. Stock Type Mares Halter
- *4. Open Gaited Horse Halter (Tennessee Walker/Fox trotter types)
- Model Horse Halter (Arab/ Morgan/ Saddlebred types; gaited excluded-All shown in halter with exception of Saddlebreds)
- 6. Open Showmanship
- 7. Lead Line (Horse or pony; walk and trot; 6 years and under rider cannot show in any pleasure classes.)
- 8. Jr. Egg and Spoon (15 years and under)
- 9. Sr. Egg and Spoon (16 years and older)
- 10. Open English Pleasure (All ages/any breed)
- **11. Youth Pole bending** (10 years and under; horse or pony helmet required.)
- 12 Jr. Pole Bending (11-15; Horse or pony.)
- 13. Sr. Pole Bending (16 years and older)
- 14. Jr. Western Pleasure (15 years and younger; 55" and over)
- *15. Jr. Country Pleasure (15 years and under: flat foot walk and favorite gait; open tack and attire; no pads)
- **16. Jr. Walk-Trot** (15 years and under; horse; gaited excluded: rider cannot ride in class 10, 14, 22, 23, or 30)
- *17. Sr. County Pleasure (16 years and older: flat foot walk and favorite gait; western tack and attire; lite shod shoes only.)
- **18. Pony Walk Trot** (13 years and under; 55" and under; rider cannot show class 10, 14, 22, 23, or 30)

- **19. Youth Barrels** (10 years and under; Horse or pony; Helmet required.)
- 20. Jr. Barrels (11-15 years; Horse or pony)
- 21. Sr. Barrels (16 years and older)
- **22. Non- Stock Open Pleasure** (All ages; 55" or over; Arab/ Morgan/ Saddlebred type; Gaited excluded.)
- 23. Stock Type Open Western Pleasure (All ages; Men and Women; 55" and over)
- *24. Plantation (All ages; heavy shod)
- *25. Open Lite Shod Pleasure (All ages; flat foot walk and favorite gait; open tack and attire; lite shod shoes only.)
- 26. Jr. Flag (15 years and under; Horse or Pony)
- 27. Sr. Flag (16 years and older)
- **28.** Adult Walk-Trot (16 years and older; gaited excluded; riders cannot ride in classes 10, 22, 23, 30 or 32)
- Open Western Horsemanship Walk-Trot/Gaited (all ages; any breed)
- **30. Jr. Horse** (Stock-Type horses 5 Years and younger)
- *31. Open Gaited (All ages; any gaited breed; open tack and attire; flat foot walk and favorite gait; no pads)
- Adult Stock Type Western Pleasure (16 years and older; 55" and over)
- 33. Jr. Plug Race (15 years and younger; horse or pony)
- **34. Sr. Plug Race** (16 years and older)
- 35. Timed Trail Class (All ages/any breed; walk, trot, gait)
- LOCATION: Ste. Genevieve County Fairgrounds
- I-55 South to East on Hwy 32 (becomes 4th St.), continue and follow signs to fairgrounds.
- Alternative route; get off Hwy 55 Junc. O to Hwy 61 stay on it 5.7 miles, turn Left on Industrial River road. Follow signs to fairgrounds.
- 4-H Concessions on grounds.

- Listen to 98.5 FM for rain cancellation
- Rules posted at entry booth.
- Suitable attire required in all classes.
- Hats required in all classes except speed.

- -Must show 4 of the 6-point shows to be eligible for high point awards.
- Helmet required in all youth classes ages 10 & under
- Hitting the horse in front of the saddle is a disqualification *Gaited horses No pad, open frog, legal plantation shoes.
- Lite shod classes must have ½ ¾ shoe size.
- -Exhibitors under 18 years MUST have a parent or responsible party sign for them (DOB as of Jan. 1, 2011)
- -Boots with defined heels are required for all riding classes.
- -Class ages are as of January 1, 2011
- -You MUST be 16 years of age to handle a stallion.
- -Palming the barrel is a disqualification
- -Speed horses MUST enter and exit the ring under control
