Current ARHA membership card must be presented at time of entry. Owner and exhibitor addresses also required on entries. Exhibitor will be required to pay for each class, shown in or not, unless a drop sheet is submitted at least two classes prior to showing of class. MoRHA classes (#14, #33, #39, #40) do not accrue ARHA points or club points toward MoRHA High Point. These classes open to all horses, ARHA registered or not. Must be a MoRHA member to be eligible for year-end club awards. All youth classes are 1 6 and under. Negative Coggins required for all horses. Health certificates required for out of state horses. All dogs must be on a leash. Smoking allowed in outside designated areas only. Excessive use of alcohol will result in dismissal from grounds.
