Show 2 Days – Show in all Classes

Open, Solid Paint Bred, Novice Amateur, Amateur Walk-Trot, Solid Paint Bred Amateur, Amateur - Pay flat fee of \$135 per horse.
Includes all charges for 4 judges – Entries, office & 1 stall for the weekend.

Youth Walk-Trot, Novice Youth & Youth - Pay flat fee of \$85 per horse. Includes all charges for 4 judges – Entries, office & 1 stall for the weekend.

MPHC Open Walk Trot Classes – \$4. per judge. **Additional Stalls** - \$60 for the weekend.

Show 1 Day – Show in all Classes

Open, Solid Paint Bred, Novice Amateur, Amateur Walk-Trot, Solid Paint Bred Amateur & Amateur - Pay flat fee of \$67.50. per horse.
