She is sought after as an instructor & judge. She has trained both horse and rider champions since 1986. Boo trained under Gordon Wright learning the same techniques used by George Morris.

Clinic will emphasize:

- Goals for you & your horse for the clinic and show season
- Review tack fit for each horse, reasons for your tack choices, etc.
- Review your training for gaps in order to fill them including adjusting rider position
- Boo will ride your horse if needed to find a solution to problems
- What a judge looks for in you & your horse how to put your best foot forward in a show

Group sessions for Hunters, Jumpers or Equitation will be limited to 5 riders per group Closing date for entries – Friday, April 13th
