Youth may not handle or ride a stallion in a youth class.

For the open breed classes; the Appaloosa halter classes will probably take at least a couple hours before the open breed halter classes start.

There are many classes, and we would like to get through them at a decent pace. Please do your best to be ready when your class is coming up. We will do our best to let you know where we are in the class order. If you need a tack change, please let us know in advance. We will have a 3 minute gate call, unless a tack change has been requested. If you need any help, please do not hesitate to ask!

The open breed classes are eligible for ACAAP merits.
