\*PONIES MAY SHOW IN PONY DESIGNATED CLASSES ONLY. PONIES MUST BE 54" AND UNDER.

Pee Wee participants may only show in pee wee designated classes and the following additional classes: 2,4,5,21,22,23,24,25,26,27,28 Pee Wee participants must be youth 10 and under.
