Entry fee is \$30.00 per rider for the show or \$8 for an individual class. Ribbons awarded in each class 1st-6th place. Prizes to winners in each class.

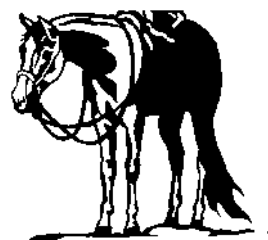

- Saddle Award for High Point 4H from Montgomery County (see requirements)

All Horses must have a negative Coggins. Walk Trot Classes open to all ages who are not ready to lope. If you lope at least 3 strides in any walk/trot class, you will be disqualified. Riders may not cross enter divisions on the same horse.

All exhibitors are required to wear their entry number in judged classes and must have appropriate tack and equipment. Helmets are highly encouraged in all class and required in speed classes for ages 12 and under. No running through gate for speed events. Horsemanship classes may use English or Western tack and attire.

Not responsible for accidents, losses or injury.
Decision of the judge and superintendent are final.
