**ApHC classes will be required to pay judges' fees in addition to entry fees as follows below:*

\$1 per class per judge for youth & Non-Pro ApHC classes

\$2 per class per judge for open ApHC classes

\$10 per class or \$45 For unlimited OPEN Breed Classes ONLY, for one horse and rider pair.

Grounds fee: \$5.00 per horse, any breed (numbers are assigned to the horse)

Ribbons will be awarded for both judges.
